## ABOUT THE CAMPS

### DAY CAMP (Grades 3-12)

Monday, June 14 - Thursday, June 17: 9 a.m. - 3 p.m.

Campers will be grouped by their age and talent level. Check-in for the camp is from 8:15-9 a.m. on Monday at the Frericks Center. These camps will focus on individual skill development, fundamental reinforcement and exciting games. In addition, you will be taught by Dayton Flyer coaches team members. The Day Camp will have a Championship game at 1:15 p.m. and an award ceremony at 2 p.m. on Thursday.

### MORE ABOUT COACH JABIR

- Jabir was named one of 10 finalists for the Kay Yow Coach of the Year Award.
- Jabir led the 2010 Flyers to one of their best seasons ever. He led Dayton to its first D-I NCAA Tournament where UD won its First Round game over TCU. The Flyers were ranked in the AP and USA Today/ESPN polls for the first time in history, reaching as high as No. 20 in both polls.
- UD won more A-10 games in the history of the program and had five players earn All-Conference honors, also the most ever for the Flyers.
- The 2010 Flyers finished with 25 wins, tying the Dayton modern era record.
- Jabir guided Dayton to the third best turnaround in the nation in 2007-08. That same team earned votes in the AP Top 25 Poll for the first time in school history. Plus, they had the longest winning streak in the nation and in program history.
- Jabir was tabbed as the 2008 Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year after guiding the Flyers to a school-record 25 victories and their second-ever postseason berth with a trip to the WNIT.
- Jabir has over 300 career wins as a head coach and instructed players at Buffalo State, Siena, Marquette, Providence and Colorado before coming to Dayton.
